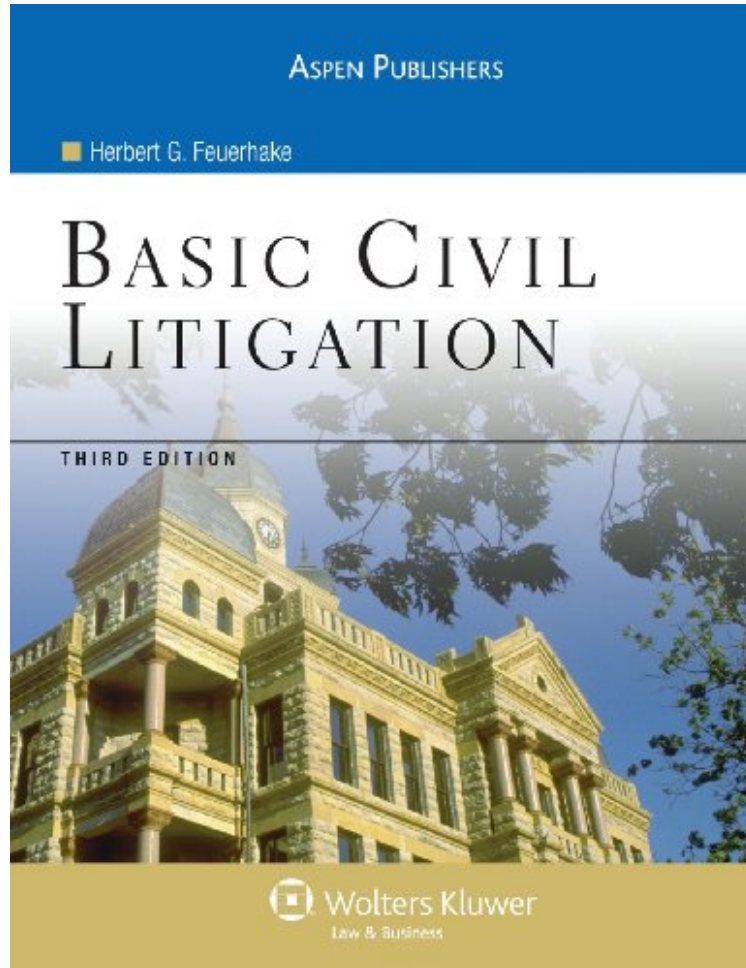

Every Aspen book I've dealt with has been absolutely terrible. The writing is rambling, wordy, semi coherent, and after two or three pages of unfocused blather will inevitably end by saying, "check the statutes in your area". It almost seems as if the author was being paid by the word, or was told to produce a specific number of pages to satisfy his contract with the publishing company. This particular book is 415 pages long, not including appendices, glossary and index. If clearly and concisely written, as any good textbook should be, the actual information contained in this book would fill only about 200 pages, and half of that number would be instructional images, such as document samples. I am an A student, so my dissatisfaction with this book in particular, and Aspen Publishing books in general has nothing to do with lack of understanding of the

subject matter, and everything to do with the poor quality of the books produced.
