If you are interested in getting a firm grasp of the subject you cannot do better. The only reason that I have not given the book five stars is that while the theory is covered in depth, the book's coverage of reinsurance markets and how they operate is a bit sketchy; presumably it simply was not Professor Carter's intent to cover that.
