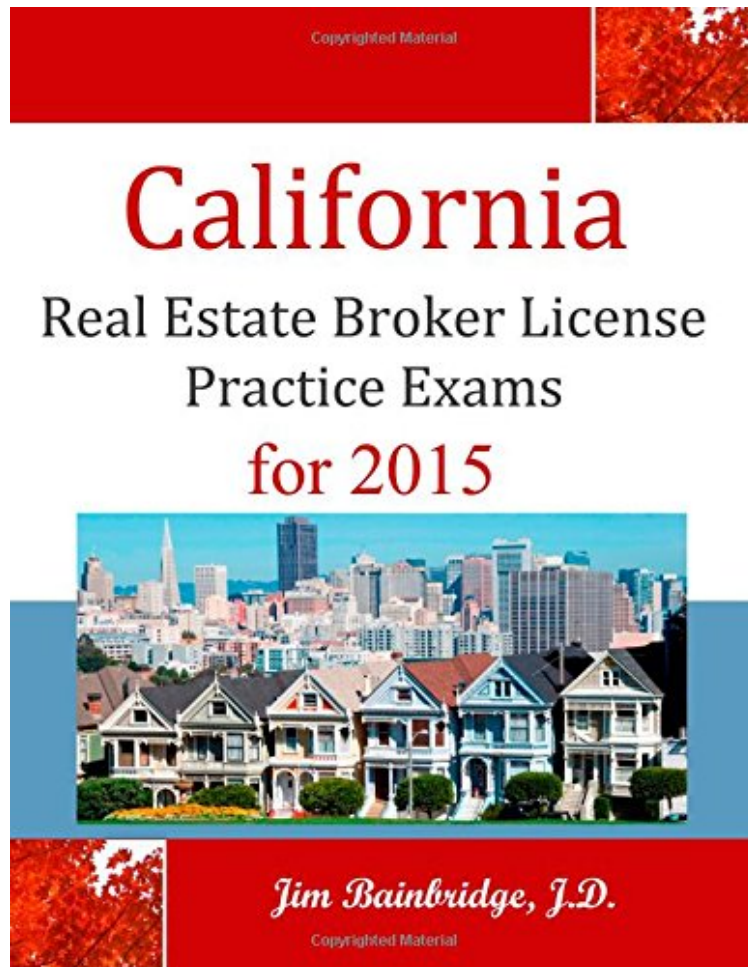

I had to take the exam 4 times before I passed and so I have a pretty good idea of the exam questions now. I bought this book to study on my own and save money from attending a 1 or 2 day crash course that most of my friends had suggested. But, I ended up spending more money on fees retaking the exam. This book needs to be updated with current material on the actual

test and written similar to the actual test questions. I would say that only 20% of this material appeared in questions that I saw on the tests and I didn't come across any math questions on any of my exams. I would save your money on purchasing this book until it's updated. 5 of 6 people found the following review helpful. Not sure if the 2015 test format has changed or not but there were no math questions on the actual exam so the math questions on the practice test aren't useful. And it appears I didn't pass primarily because of a very poor result on the Property Ownership and Land Use Controls and Regulations section according to the BREs printout I was given when leaving. Just an average score on that section would've probably put me into a pass category overall. So I'll end up ordering another course in hopes these questions are covered in greater detail so I can pass the next time. Maybe I'm to blame but I feel the practice questions missed the mark on an apparently important aspect of the test.
