Each volume begins with an overview of history and ancient culture, including material about where the people came from, how they adapted to their environment, and the stories they tell. Information on contemporary issues is here as well, especially about the peoples' struggles to adapt to modern technology without losing sight of their cultures and rights. That's a lot to cover in 32 pages, and some packed historical sections may confuse readers. But there's no romance about exotic primitives, and the bright color photos, most of contemporary places and people, bring the facts very close--particularly the pictures of young people wearing jeans and using computers, who want to preserve traditions despite global warming, pollution, tourism, and other threats.
