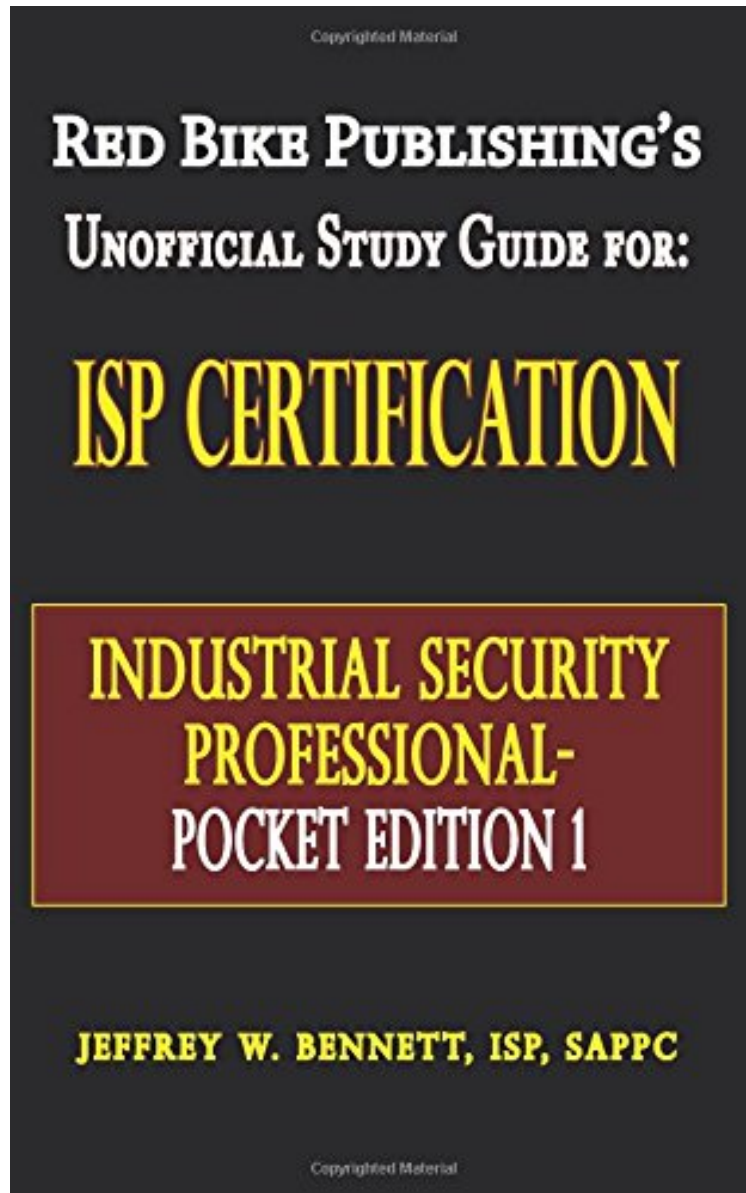

I also offer advice for security specialists to advance in their career. However, the primary purpose of our book is to provide practice exams. The workbook the reviewer mentions had 15 questions when I took it. This book has 220 and my other has 440. That is why the book is almost 100% questions, answers and references to where to find the answers in NISPOM. Though not endorsed by the NCMS, this book was authored by a board certified ISP and edited and reviewed ISPs.
