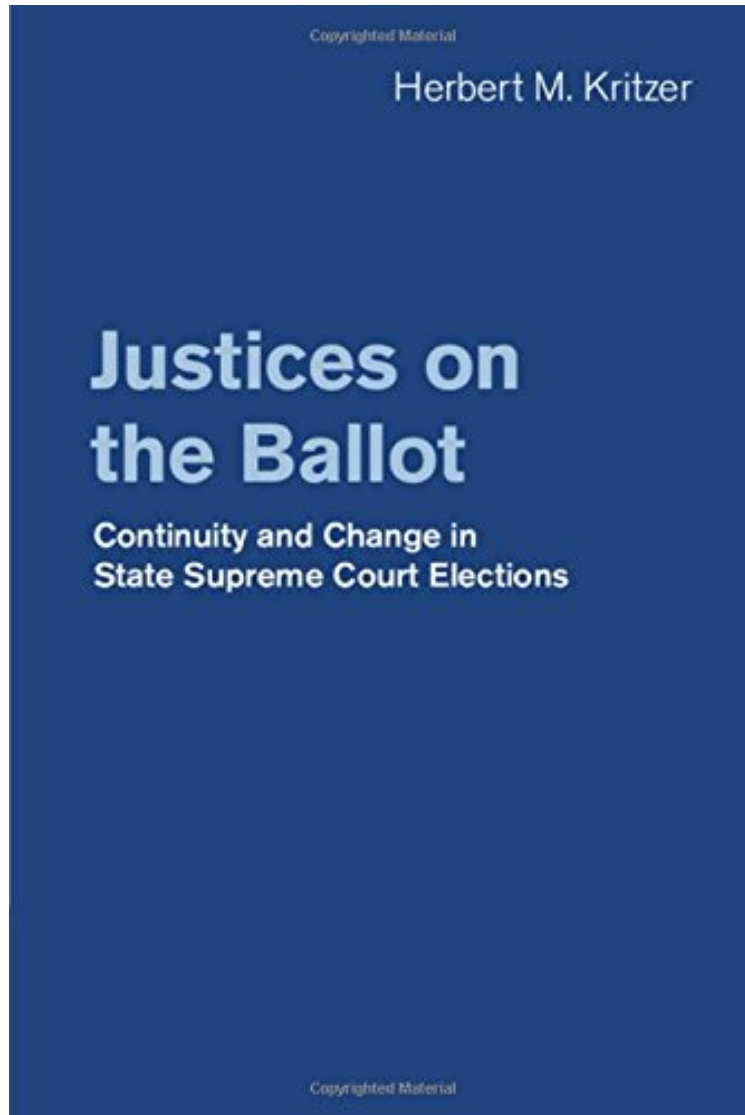


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# Justices on the Ballot: Continuity and Change in State Supreme Court Elections
