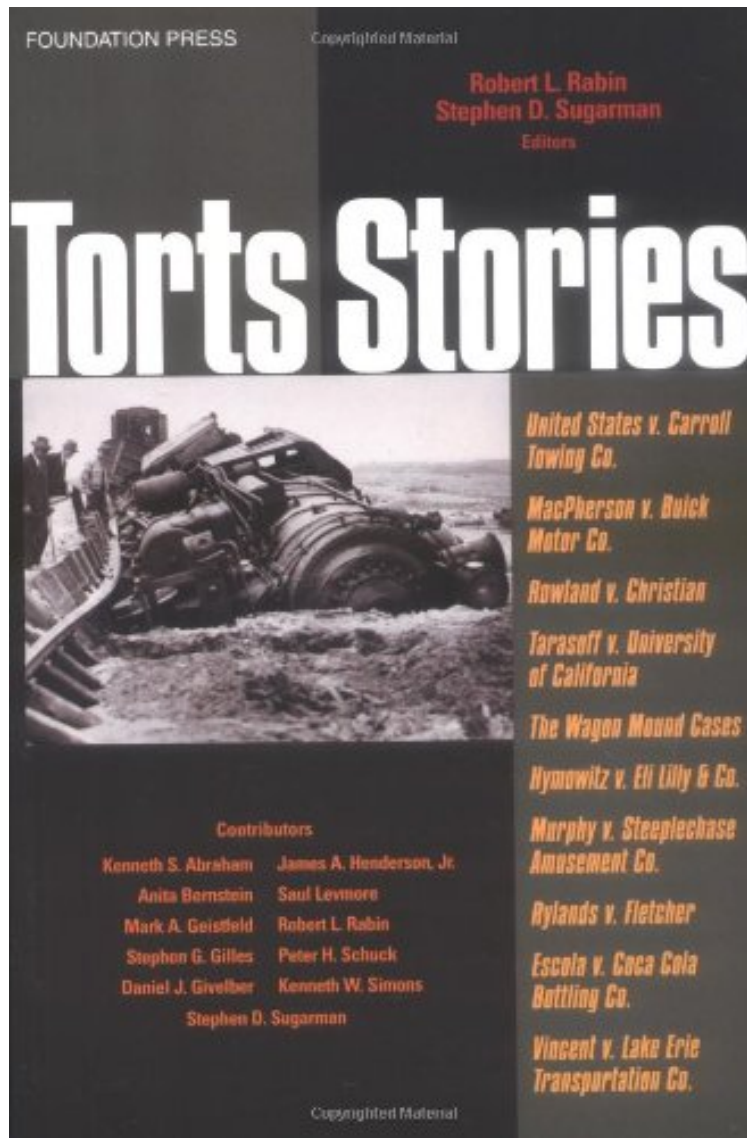

Basically the main idea of the book, to me, is that it takes a bunch of torts cases that are covered in most 1L torts classes but tells the larger stories. Torts is infamous for boiling away the human element and focusing on "was their a duty that was neglected, was their proximate cause, etc..." but this book, which is very accessible, humanizes the issue and, by so doing, forces any torts student to consider the larger consequences of how we conduct torts litigation.
